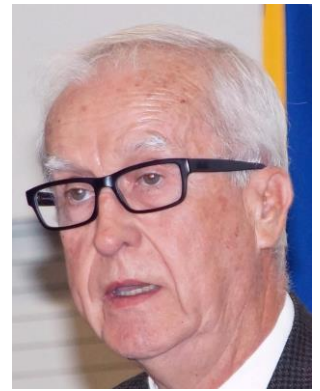
Sing along: Ed Schweitzer led the sing along with Bruce Lundgren at the piano for three songs.

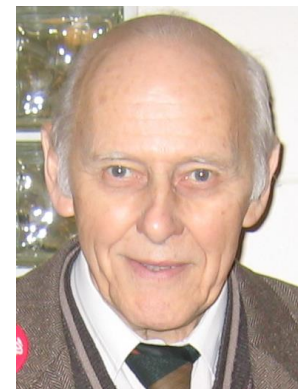


PROGRAM

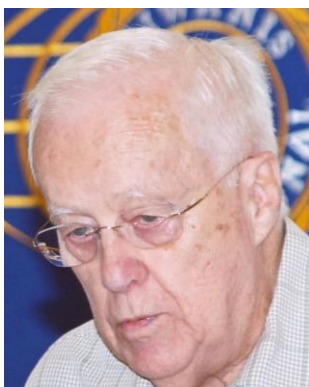
