03 May 2018 MEETING NEWS

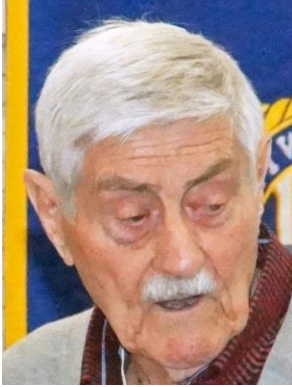
