The recipient receives a special certificate, a \$500 cheque for the charity of his/her choice from among those currently supported



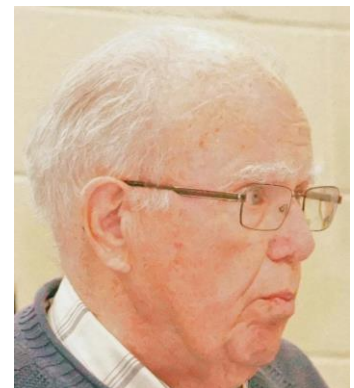

**Treasurer for 2017-18 presented statements showing the club's current financial position to April 30, 2018.**

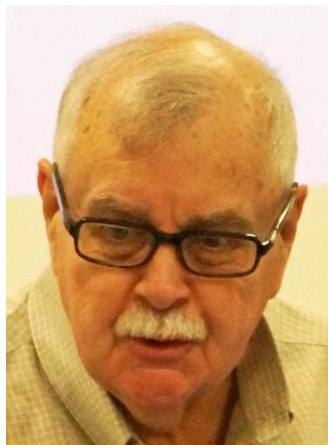
**Crandall Benson was thanked for reviewing the 2016-17 statements.**
