Chip Martin, a retired London Free Press reporter was introduced by Russ Knight. Chip gave us an analysis of the London City election held on October 22nd. He said there was a 39% turnout down from the voter turnout in 2014. He said the ranked ballot had to go to 14 rounds before the Mayor was elected with the required 50% + 1 vote. Two of the councillors were elected without the 50% + 1 vote. Several unfair things happened during the election e.g. some councillors were victims of fake websites and there was damage done to election signs. There are several new councillors elected. Chip questioned the value of allowing many candidates (14 in the case of the most recent election) ran for mayor as it meant the candidates meetings are long as each person has to be given equal time. The first black woman Arielle Kayabaga was elected to





City Council in Ward 13. Chip praised Cathy Saunders, City Clerk for organizing such a smooth election and said Cathy is the best city clerk he has seen in the 40 years he covered city hall politics. Russ Gonder thanked the speaker.
