Labatt Virtual Archives which are now housed at the Weldon Library at Western. It is a virtual collection because the archival contents are now accessible online. Labatt's was founded by John Labatt in 1847 and the collection follows much of

the history of Canada e.g. how Labatts survived probation, how Labatt's used the railways to market its products, sending Labatt's products overseas to troops during war time and does so even today.
