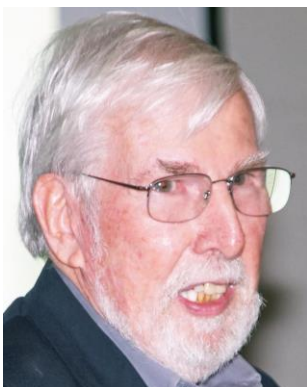
### 15 November 2018 MEETING NEWS
