Club Meeting 29 March

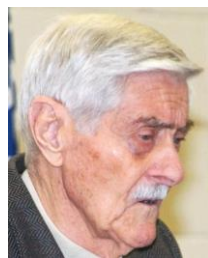

In his talk LG Doug told us some interesting facts about Kiwanis which included: there are 600,000 Kiwanis members in 80 countries. When the project Eliminate was begun there were 59 countries which had neo natal Tetanus and now 44 of those countries are considered Tetanus free. The District we belong to Eastern Canada and the Caribbean consists of many countries and 4 major languages (English, French, Dutch and Spanish). There are over 20 divisions, more than 6,000 members and 7 clubs within our Division 4. The Bahamas is not considered part of the Caribbean.
