Among the second- and third-grade children enrolled at Chrysanthemum Village Elementary School in San Pedro, Laguna, Philippines, 33 have some sort of reading deficiency. For some, it's difficult to read syllables. Others don't even recognize the alphabet.

Members of the Kiwanis Club of Laguna Gems, San Pedro, Laguna wanted to change that statistic.

After consulting with school staff, they launched the A Kiwanian and You (AKAY) program. The name is appropriate, says Nicasia "Nikki" Canchela, past president and current club member, because in local parlance, akay means to guide or lend a helping hand.
