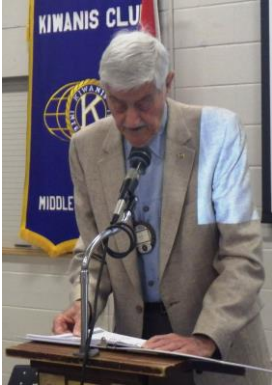
02 August 2018 MEETING NEWS

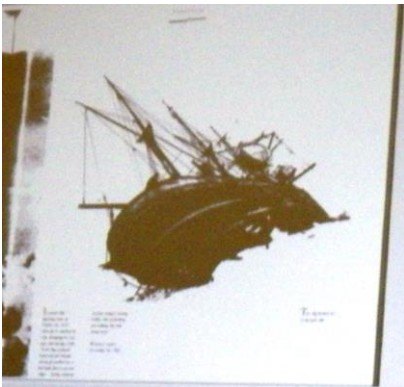

Bob Curtis began his presentation by giving us brief background information about Ernest Shackleton who Bob described as being a great leader as he had the extraordinary ability to choose men who were compatible and could work together. Some said he was one the greatest leaders ever on earth.

After joining the Merchant Navy at age 16 he had his Captain's papers by age 24. Although the First World War was looming on the horizon Winston Churchill, First Lord



of the Admiralty decreed Shackleton's expedition would go on so in in October 1914 Shackleton and his crew set off from Argentina in the ship Eneavour. This ship had been built in Norway especially for Arctic expeditions.

By June 1915 the Endearvour was stranded in pack ice and the Expedition had to abandon the ship. There was very

little depression among the crew and after many hardships they reached a whaling station on South Georgia Island. Remarkably Shackleton and all 22 crew members survived. Shackleton failed in all three attempts he made to reach the South Pole although on at least one occasion he came close to reaching the South Pole.

In 1922 Ernest Shackleton (age 47) died of a heart attack while in Antarctica and is buried on South Georgia Island. Russ Knight both introduced and thanked Bob for his presentation.

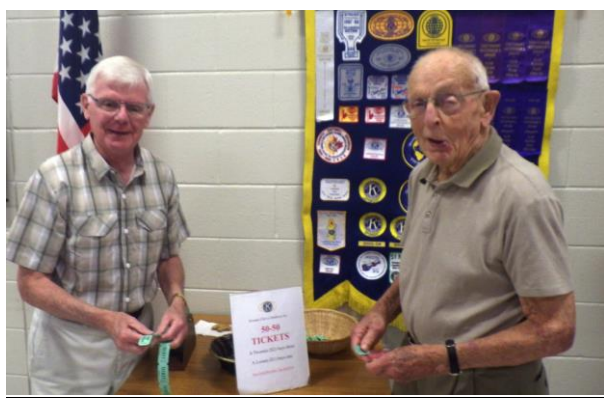
