position she has held for about 30 years. The program is run in space at the London Food Bank. Arts include a variety of different ones including: music and dance. The program works to develop children's imaginations. Free instruction in various arts are provided for children whose families can't afford to provide this benefit. Children can stay with the program until age 13. Some students come back as teachers. Volunteers for the program come from groups such as university students, retirees, and new teachers. A child must want to be in the program not the parent wanting the child to be in the program. There are currently 67



students enrolled and each person can take 2 arts e.g. music and art. London Community Foundation provides some funding. In addition to financial donations also items such as musical instruments, piano books and costumes are welcome. Karen said they hope to expand the program to include kids who 'age out of the current program'. Bob Curtis thanked Karen for her presentation.
