**This is the red building located right beside the Kiwanis Seniors Centre.**

**The program opened a whole new world for her and changed her life.**

**She could talk to the other kids in the program and be herself in a way different from regular school.**

**JA is a global organization that teaches business education to kids at elementary and high school level.**

**JA Volunteers arrange with teachers to give presentations during school hours.**

**Elementary kids get talks on financial management like how to**

**create a lifestyle budget.**

**High school kids get presentations on entrepreneurship, starting a business, investments, or work readiness.**

**In addition to the school programs there is a free after-school program and summer camps.**

**JA is a registered charity and gets no government or United Way funding.**

**Financial support is through individual and business donations, and service clubs.**

**JA priority is to increase giving the program to underserved youth. Both household income or parents with minimum education are factors to determined "underserved."**

### Kiwanis Education 19 September 2024

**The Kiwanis general liability insurance covers fund-raising and service activities involving the public as well as club activities confined to the membership. Because a high percentage of public liability exposure is the result of a club's fund-raising and service activities, clubs are permitted to allocate from revenue of fund-raising projects, as a legitimate expense, all premium charges over and above a basic sum of 25 cents (US) per member per year. The 25 cents must be paid from the club's administrative account.**
