Dr Robbie Campbell a psychiatrist who was introduced by Bob Curtis told us he has had a life long focus on eating disorders. He has now established 'The Harbour' for treatment and support of Western and Fanshawe students with Eating Disorders as currently there is no

treatment program for this serious mental illness. Eating disorders can start as early as 3 yrs old and go right to senior citizens. The Harbour clinic is setting up a team approach to deal with many issues e.g. PTSD. Many youth programs end at age 18 yrs and there are long waitlists for adult programs that is why 'The Harbour' clinic was established. Anorexia Nervosa has one of the highest mortality rates among psychiatric illnesses. Females



between 18 and 24 are more likely to die from Anorexia than all other causes combined. Without timely care recovery is harder and the risk greater. Besides eating disorders a person might also over exercise. It is hoped to eventually to have the program throughout

Canada. The reason for the fundraiser is because OHIP only covers the medical expenses. Carol Turnbull thanked the speaker for his presentation.
